JUNIOR LEAGUE OF HAMPTON ROADS 2020-2021 VOLUNTEER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Junior League of Hampton Roads was founded in 1956 and is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism and improving the community through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. The Volunteer Scholarship was established in 2018 to support the volunteer potential of our youth by awarding one or more scholarships ranging from \$500-\$3000+ to high school young women who demonstrate outstanding volunteer performance in the community. We have awarded six scholarships to graduating women seniors in the past three years.

Candidates for the Volunteer Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

- ___ 1. Must be a graduating, female senior, who has earned a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 and from Hampton, Newport News, York County, Williamsburg, Poquoson, Smithfield, Isle of Wight, or Gloucester (private or public) schools.
- ___ 2. Must enroll as a full-time student in any private or public post-secondary institution in the coming school year.
- ___ 3. Must be involved in a volunteer capacity in the community. Volunteer work must be separate from any that is required by student's school.

Application Procedures:

- ___ 1. Complete the application, including the Volunteer Experience Log, questions, Volunteer Supervisor Recommendation Form, and Teacher or Adult Mentor Recommendation Form. The application must be completed in its entirety – all questions must be answered.
- ___ 2. Submit your application to the Junior League of Hampton Roads.
