



## 2022 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE GRANT APPLICATION

The Junior League of Hampton Roads (JLHR) was founded in 1956, and is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving communities through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Our vision as the Junior League is *Women Around the World as Catalysts of Lasting Community Change*. The Community Assistance Grant was established in 1980 to support 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations that are contributing to work that improves lives of women and/or children in our local communities of Newport News, Hampton, Poquoson, York County, Williamsburg, James City County, Isle of Wight, Smithfield, and Gloucester. Our specific areas of impact for 2022 are childhood literacy, hunger/food insecurity, and racial injustice. This grant has been awarded to over 200 organizations in our area over the past 41 years.

Up to three organizations may be selected as a Grant Recipient and awarded between \$500-\$4000 to continue their work. If you have been a recipient of this grant in the past, we ask that you wait to apply for the grant again until two years have elapsed.
