Tour of Trucks FAQs

HOW MUCH ARE TICKETS?

General admission tickets are \$7/ticket or \$25/ticket for a Family 4-Pack. VIP tickets are available for pre-purchase online only, and include early access starting at 11AM, VIP Bags (for the first 200 kids to arrive), an egg hunt, and a raffle ticket for prizes.

Tickets will be available for purchase on-site; cash and credit card payments accepted.

HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY TICKET?

There are no physical event tickets. If you purchase tickets on the JLHR website ahead of the event, you should receive an email confirmation of your purchase and your name will be available at will-call at event check-in. You can purchase tickets here.

IF I GAVE MY TICKETS TO SOMEONE ELSE, HOW DO THEY CHECK-IN?

Please email Truck@JLHamptonRoads.org to provide their name and your name. If your tickets were gifted to you by anyone else, please check in the General Admission desk and provide their name.

WILL I BE ABLE TO WALK ON THE RACEWAY?

YES! TOUR OF TRUCKS is hosted on the raceway at Larry King Law's Langley Speedway. Vehicles will be located throughout the race track.

WHAT IF IT RAINS?

TOUR OF TRUCKS is a rain or shine event. The event is outdoors, without covering: Sunscreen and umbrellas are advised, dependent upon weather.

WILL THERE BE PARKING?

Yes, patrons can park at Langley Speedway.

WILL THERE BE RESTROOMS?

Access to restrooms at Langley Speedway will be available on-site.

WILL THERE BE FOOD & BEVERAGES?

We will have 3 food trucks available on-site: Get Cheesy, Over the Moon Pizza, and Kona Ice. They will offer food and beverages. Alcohol will NOT be available for purchase.

WHAT CAN I BRING TO THE EVENT?

You can bring:

- Cameras and smart phones to take photos.
- Picnic blankets, towels, or chairs to sit on, but please leave tents, large umbrellas and parasols at home.
- A stroller or wagon if it is for an infant or toddler
- A service animal

You cannot bring:

 This is a smoke-free event. Cigarettes or e-cigs are not allowed within the perimeter of the event.

- No coolers.
- No outside food or drink allowed. Unless your child/ren requires a special food style.
- Bicycles and scooters are not allowed within the perimeter of the event.

WHICH TYPES OF VEHICLES WILL BE ON DISPLAY AT THE EVENT?

We will have over 40 vehicles on display at TOUR OF TRUCKS this year! This will include vehicles from Hampton Police Department, Hampton Fire Department, Virginia Marine Police, VDOT, and so many more. Review some of our community partners here.

WILL I RECEIVE AN EVENT MAP?

You will receive a detailed map of the truck and activities on the day of the event at check-in.

WHEN IS QUIET HOUR?

Quiet hour will run from approximately 2:00PM to 3:00PM. There will be no horns, lights or sirens to allow those with special needs or sensitive hearing to attend and enjoy the event. During the hours prior, children will be encouraged to honk the horns, sound the sirens, etc. and it can get very loud, so consider bringing ear protection for very young children or adults who may be startled by the noise.

WHAT IS TOUR OF TRUCKS FUNDRAISING FOR?

As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, event proceeds will help support the Junior League of Hampton Roads and its community programs. The JLHR is a women's leadership and volunteer organization. Our primary mission is to develop and train women to be effective volunteers in the local community. This year, we are focused on addressing family services and education needs on the Peninsula.
